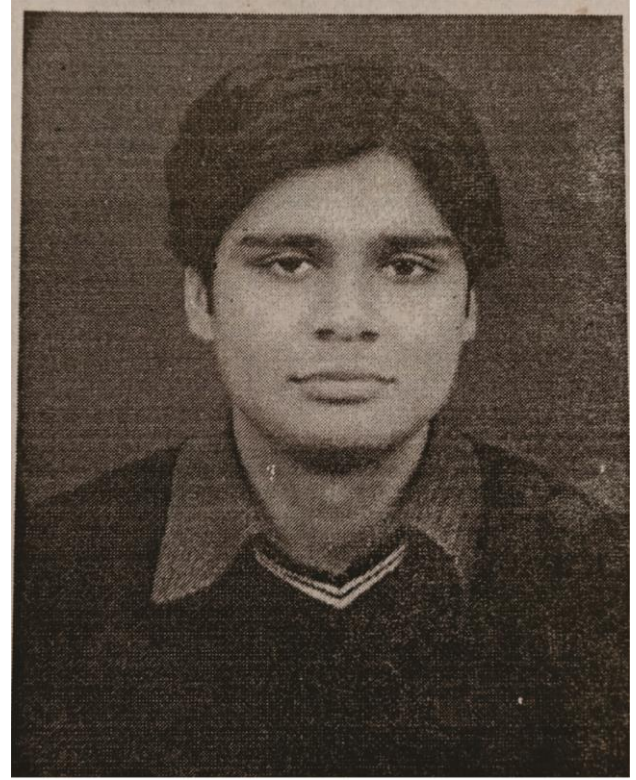
To achieve our aim we offer:

# School Rules & Associated Behaviour

## *1. General Rules:*

- 1)** Every student is required to arrive in the school before 5 minutes of the school time in the morning.
- 2)** All students must attend the school assembly.
- 3)** At the first stroke of the bell, all must fall in line immediately and form lines for the assembly where they will recite Prayers and subsequently move silently to their class-rooms. Assembly is meant to create in them discipline and order in life.
- 4)** Late comers should bring a note of explanation from their parents.
- 5)** All are expected to speak in ENGLISH or URDU in SCHOOL.
- 6)** Utmost cleanliness must be observed in school premises. Throwing litter, pieces of paper, seeds and skins of fruits is strictly prohibited. Use of dustbins provided, should be made for this purpose.
- 7)** Writing or scribbling on walls, chairs, desks, benches or anywhere else is strictly prohibited.
- 8)** Any kind of damage done by pupils to the school equipments, furniture, building, etc. will have to make good and penalty shall be decided by the Principal. The students will have to pay the penalty.
- 9)** Strict regularity, implicit obedience, politeness, courtesy in speech and conduct and cleanliness of books, notebooks, dresses and person are rigidly insisted upon.
- 10)** Silence must be observed in the corridors and on the stairs during class hours. They should not be found talking in between periods.
- 11)** Students are also required not to run around inside the school building.
- 12)** No books (other than Text or Library books), newspapers or periodicals should be brought to School. Any objectionable literature found in possession of the student justifies dismissal.
- 13)** The school shall not be held responsible for books, money, clothes and other articles lost in the school. Students must look after their own things. It is not advisable for pupils to have money, mobile, valuable articles or jewellery with them. Harmful or lethal objects should not be brought to school. Beware, it is criminal to carry harmful or lethal objects.
- 14)** Fancy watches are not allowed to be worn in the school and will be confiscated. Students from 8<sup>th</sup> class only will be allowed to wear simple wrist watches.
- 15)** The school gate will be closed one hour before break time and will reopen after half an hour of the break.
- 16)** Parents are requested to deliver the lunch to the school before the closing of gates and in time so that the lunch may be delivered to the student easily before lunch break.

- 17)** Mobile Phones are not permitted in the school premises. Any student found carrying a mobile phone will be confiscated and a heavy penalty will be levied on the students.
- 18)** Birthdays are not allowed to be celebrated in the school by distributing eatables, sweets or any kind of presents. (except the pre-classes)
- 19)** Pupils are answerable to the school authorities for their conduct both in and even outside the School. Hence misbehavior in public places and conveyance is punishable. Every student should endeavour to keep up high tone of the school by excelling in good manners and deportment.
- 20)** The school management will not be responsible for the security of vehicles e.g. bikes, motorcycles, cars of the visitors as well as the students.
- 21)** A student who is unwell should not be sent to school. In case of emergency, parents will be contacted immediately to take the child for medical attention. Failing contact with the parents, the child will be taken to nearby hospital (Saeed Surgical Govt. Colony Road) by the administration for necessary treatment. In case of illness, medical fees and transport charges will be borne by the parents. Students suffering from contagious or infectious diseases are not permitted to attend the school.
- 22)** Any sort of complaints / suggestions regarding school matters should be handed over to the Principal office and not to the class teachers.
- 23)** Any correspondence by the parents should be on a separate application on a full size paper and must be sent in an envelope.
- 24)** Parents or Guardians can request a meeting with the teacher only with the prior permission of the Principal and should never approach the teacher directly in the classroom. Meeting will be held in the Vice Principal office.
- 25)** A student who comes to school without school bag or in colour clothes will not be admitted to class and will be marked absent.
- 26)** For breach of any school rules, a student may be fined / punished at the discretion of the Principal. The decision of the Principal will be final.
- 27)** Students must bring books according to the specified time-table. They must see that all books and notebooks are neatly covered and labelled.
- 28)** Students are not allowed to be in classes during break time, unless they are on detention.
- 29)** Students are strictly forbidden to leave the school premises at unusual times. In case of emergency/sickness an application should be made to the Principal for seeking permission.
- 30)** No student is allowed to leave the classroom for any reason without the permission.
- 31)** Students/Parents should avoid offering gifts or presents to any of the staff at any time.
- 32)** Each and every student must be provided with glasses and water bottles by the parents so that they may fill or refill in the school during break in order to keep them safe from infectious and contagious diseases such as Hepatitis, T.B, measles, mumps, etc.

## *ii. Uniform:-*

- 1) All students must wear only prescribed uniform on all weekdays without making any alterations in any articles. It should always be neat and clean.
- 2) Coloured dress is allowed only on Colour Days and on other occasions as and when announced by the school.
- 3) The nails, haircut and uniform of the students will be checked on every Monday. The hair should properly be trimmed. Nail painting of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- 4) Tattoos, bangles, goggles, fancy pins, etc. are strictly not allowed to be worn in the school.
- 5) The students who wish to participate in plays, skits, stage performance, P.T, sports, guard of honour will have to prepare their dresses accordingly at their own cost.
- 6) Boys must have a regular crew-cut. The student boys are not allowed to grow either moustaches or beard. The girls can arrange their hair in 1 or 2 braids and tie them up with black or navy blue ribbon or 2 pony tails with black or navy ribbon. Black hair band must be used for short hair.
- 7) There must be a special mark inside the blazer or sweater of the students for identification.

## *iii. Absence:-*

- 1) Irregular attendance and unjustified absence justifies dismissal. Students must not be kept away from the School for celebrations like engagements, marriages, etc.
- 2) In case of a long sickness, an application duly signed by the parents must be sent to the Principal on a neat sheet of paper enclosed in an envelope with appropriate details written on it along with medical certificate. Parents must not wait to send this intimation until the child recovers. Parents must produce a medical certificate for absence on account of illness.
- 3) Students will be marked present only if they represents the school in competitions. For private competition he/she will be, marked absent.
- 4) Absence for any other reason would be permitted only with the prior permission from the Principal. Leaving the school premises without Principal's permission is strictly prohibited. In case, if any student manages to go out of the school during school time without permission, the school will not be responsible for his/her act as well as his safety. Such student will not be allowed to resume classes unless he/she is accompanied by parents. Only after discussion with parents and the student, the Principal will decide what disciplinary action should be taken.
- 5) Attendance is compulsory on first and last working day of each session and during exams.
- 6) Parents taking their children abroad during school vacations must make sure that the children attend the school on the last and first working day.
- 7) In case the child misses the syllabus completed during absence, it will be parent's responsibility to cover the syllabus.
- 8) If child remains absent from school for more than two weeks or remain mostly absent without intimation his name will be strucked off.

## *iv. Examination Rules*

- 1) We have opted for semester system comprising two semesters. There will be three monthly tests in each semester in addition to the semester exam. It will be necessary for a student to secure 50% marks in every subject. The annual result will be calculated on the basis of aggregate result of both the semesters.
- 2) It shall be necessary for the students to appear in both the term examinations. It will be considered failure if the student absented himself/ herself.
- 3) The students, who absented themselves in any paper or reappear in the same paper, will not be eligible to be included in top ten positions in their class in any way.
- 4) 10 marks will be added for punctuality, neatness and conduct of the student in every term exam.
- 5) The admission of Board class students who fail to attend 80% of the total number of delivered lectures in each subject and those who do not appear or fail in send up tests will not be sent to the board for Annual Examinations.

#### V. Admission and Withdrawal:-

- 1) The age advisable for admission to Play Group is 3 years completed on March 1<sup>st</sup> with corresponding increase for the other classes.
- 2) At the time of admission, the student must produce a leaving certificate from the recognized school last attended. If she/he comes from outside the Tehsil & District, the N.O.C. must be countersigned by the Education Officer of that place. A student, who has never attended school before, must produce the original birth certificate or B-Form.
- 3) One month notice is required for the withdrawal of the pupil or in lieu of notice fee for the following month will be charged. Such notice must be given in writing by the concerned Parent / Guardian.
- 4) No Leaving Certificate is issued until all the dues to the School are paid in full.

#### vi. Fee Rules

1. Fee will be paid in advance by the 7<sup>th</sup> of every month. After every 7<sup>th</sup> of the month a fine of Rs.50/- will be charged upto 20<sup>th</sup> and Rs.100/- till the last day of the same month.
2. Tuition fee is charged for twelve months as the staff is paid for the whole year even during the holidays.
3. Tuition fee for the month of July and August will be charged along with the fee of April and May respectively.
4. Annual fund will be charged during the month of December every year from old students and from the new entrants at the time of admission.
5. No reduction in fee is made for leave or absence.
6. Admission & Tuition fee once paid is not refunded.
7. The name of defaulters will be struck off automatically due to the non payment of Fee for two consecutive months. He will get fresh admission after observing all formalities.

#### vii. Fee Concessions

1. 50% fee concession is granted to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> sibling.
2. In case of orphan, 50% discount will be granted to deserving cases only.
3. 25% fee concession is granted to the child of Army and Police employees.
4. There is also a 50% fee concession for the twins.

*viii. Scholarships:*

- 1) The scholarships from class 3 are awarded to the students who stand first securing at least 90% of consolidated marks.
- 2) The scholarships will be as under:

For the student of	3 to 4 class	:	Rs. 1000/- per month
	5 to 7 class	:	Rs. 1500/- per month
	8 to 10 class	:	Rs.2000, Rs.1500, Rs.1000 for 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> position respectively.

*ix. For Parents:-*

- 1) When communicating with the Principal, parents are requested to mention in their letters, the standard and section of their child. If it relates to the siblings studying in different classes, their particulars are also requested to be mentioned.
- 2) Any certificate, endorsement, verification from the school should be asked for three days in advance through a handwritten application to the Principal.
- 3) Parents are expected to cooperate with the school authorities by enforcing punctuality, regularity, personal hygiene and discipline amongst their children. They will cooperate school management by ensuring that their children do their home work and prepare their lessons in time. They will be active and helpful interests in the activities of their children in the evenings keeping in view the school directions.
- 4) Parents should see that their children attend school regularly and in time. The school uniform and school books should be checked every day. The uniform must be clean, ironed and shoes regularly polished.
- 5) Parents should inculcate in their children study habits. In case of problem, the parents should see the Principal during visiting hours.
- 6) Reports or remarks sent by the Teachers must be acted upon immediately. Parents must come to collect their children's progress report cards for every term and final exam. Progress report card will not be handed over to anybody else.
- 7) Criticisms of teachers or of the school in children's presence should be avoided. You can come directly to us. Please meet the Principal regarding such matters.
- 8) Parents Teachers Meetings: PTM is arranged by school and should be attended by at least one parent as and when requested. Parents are not allowed to contact the teachers directly during school hours. In case, such a meeting is desired by the parent, prior appointment with the class or subject teacher should be taken from the Principal office.
- 9) If a Student is likely to be absent through illness for a longer, period more than 3 days, the Principal must be informed within three days. Doctor's medical certificate of fitness must be submitted to the Vice Principal on the day of resuming classes.
- 10) Parents and Guardians are specially requested to notify the school management about any change in their address and telephone numbers.
- 11) Parents, guardians or other persons are not allowed to see the pupils or call them on telephone during School hours or Interview the Teachers, while they are engaged in teaching.
- 12) Picking and dropping of the students is the responsibility of parents. After half an hour of the closing time, school will not be responsible for the security of the students. So, parents should make sure to pick their child in time.

- 13)** Parents are reminded that without their help and co-operation no significant improvement can be expected from the efforts taken by the school to mould the student's conduct in the school. They are therefore intently requested to encourage regularity and discipline in their children, and to see that their children do their home work, come to school in proper uniform, and bring all the books required for the day's work. Parents should watch their child's habits and company very closely.
- 14)** Every student shall endeavour to keep up the high standard and good reputation of the school by his/her good behavior, values, deportment and care for the humanity.

Consistent with our traditions and motto, FPS & C will in the years that lie ahead endeavour to play its own vital role in the reconstruction of society by providing access to a quality education for its students.

More applications are received than the school can accommodate. Once initial applications and requests for students for whom FPS & C is the choice have been dealt with, then additional considerations when screening applications are: character, personality, attitude, achievements and involvement.

The official language of learning and teaching is English and Urdu. FPS & C is a co-education upto class 3 and afterwards have separate buildings and premises for boys upto 10<sup>th</sup> and upto F.Sc. for girls.



### Assessment policy:

A system of continuous assessment is followed in all grades. Pupil should therefore apply themselves regularly throughout the year and not work for control tests i.e. monthly or term exams only. In the end of each academic year marks of both the terms are calculated for the final assessment and positions in each class.



### Reports on progress:

During the session PTMs (Parent Teachers Meeting) are arranged after every monthly and term exams. Parents involvement and participation is mandatory in all the PTMs to acknowledge the progress of their children and meeting with their teachers.
